

III Nephi 20 (Isaiah 52) Chiasm

- a. I will remember the covenant which I have made with my people...that I would give unto them again the land of their fathers for their inheritance, which is the land of Jerusalem (20:29)
- b. And it shall come to pass that the time cometh, when the fullness of my gospel shall be preached unto them (20:30)
- c. They shall believe in me, that I am Jesus Christ, the Son of God (20:31)
- d. Then shall their *watchmen* lift up with their voice...for they shall see eye to eye (20:32 = 52:8)
- e. Then will the Father gather them together again (20:33)
- f. The Father hath comforted his people, he hath redeemed *Jerusalem* (20:34 = 52:9)
- g. The Father hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations (20:35 = 52:10)
- h. All the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of the Father (20:35 = 52:10)
- i. Awake...put on thy strength O *Zion*; put on thy beautiful garments, O *Jerusalem* (20:36 = 52:1)
- j. Henceforth there shall not more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean (20:36 = 52:1)
- i'. Shake thyself from the dust; arise, sit down, O *Jerusalem*; loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of *Zion* (20:37 = 52:2)
- h'. Ye have sold yourselves for naught, and ye shall be redeemed without money (20:38 = 52:3)
- g'. My people shall know my name; they shall know that I am he that doth speak (20:39 = 52:6)
- f'. How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings unto them of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto *Zion*: Thy God reigneth (20:40 = 52:7)
- e'. Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence (20:41 = 52:11)
- d'. Ye shall not go out with haste nor go by flight; for the Lord will go before you, and the God of Israel shall be your *rearward* (20:42 = 52:12)
- c'. Behold, my servant shall deal prudently; he shall be exalted and extolled and be very high (20:43 = 52:13)
- b'. So shall he sprinkle many nations (20:45 = 52:15)
- a'. Then shall the covenant be fulfilled...; and then shall Jerusalem be inhabited again with my people, and it shall be the land of their inheritance (20:46)
